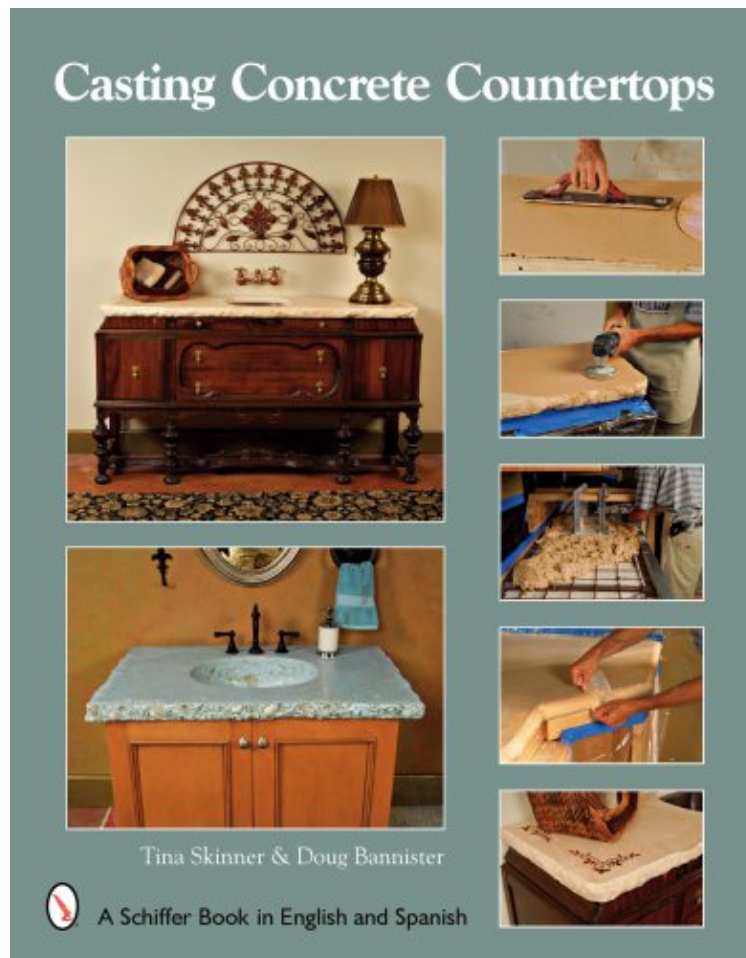

Call it instruction manual if you buy their products ie mixes, pigments, edges. I do not want to overpay for their mixes and if add cost of products, shipping and labor (possible failures), going with commercial granite installer is likely to be a better choice both financially and esthetically. I actually made a concrete countertop for my outdoor kitchen using HomeDepot white cement, decorative

gravel and \$5 bottle of pigment. Few ideas about reinforcement were helpful. Some of the projects they present look decent and some are outright ugly. It may be a reasonable book to decide which material to choose.
